

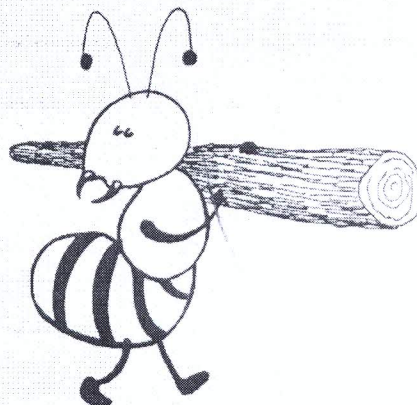
## THE ANT CITY
