Language Objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Learn new vocabulary; 2. Use tenses and structures that pupils already know; 3. Learn useful phrases. 4. Find mistakes in the written text. 5. Provide new information.
Language used for communication (BICS)	Past Simple Tense (made, stopped, saw, were...), questions and answers; Prepositions of place- between, behind, inside, into, through. Nationality: Greeks, Trojans. Time expressions: in the morning, at night. Capital letters in English language sentences.
Content Language (CALP)	...one of the ...; wooden (made of wood); fell asleep (the action before sleep); soldier; leader (the main person); gates, wall (around the city); take the city.
Content Objectives	Identifying, comparing, contrasting, reasoning, generalizing

CLIL Activity - procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Warm-up (picture- guessing) 1 min. 2. Watching a video (introduction to the lesson). 6 min. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9RYGQQ_qbY 3. Presentation of necessary content vocabulary and vocabulary necessary for practicing (by using pictures, explanations) 10 min. 4. Reading a text. 3 min. 5. Exercises (individually). 10 min. 6. Presenting individual work - reading a written text. 10 min. 7. Evaluation. 5 min.
Performance Assessment	Writing words into students' sheets: "Perfect job", "Well done", "Great work", "Great effort", "Excellent", "Very good".
TEACHER'S NOTES	Students already know about this from Science/History lessons in Lithuanian language (preknowledge).
