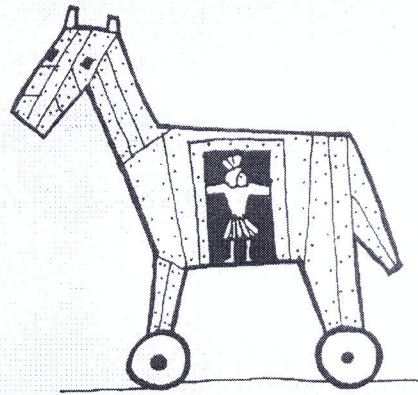


## THE TROJAN HORSE
